INSTRUCTIONS:

1. The attached form must be completed by each participant and emailed to Ken Burkett at kenburkett@comcast.net or mailed to Ken Burkett, Society for Pennsylvania Archaeology P.O. Box 213, New Bethlehem, PA 16242 before **May 12, 2024**. Payment of the \$ 150 fee for members (\$175 for non-members) is required by **May 12** as well. You may pay online using the PayPal button or by mailing a check to Ken. Each member may bring one non-member guest at the SPA member rate. Your fee covers all entrance and speaker fees, Friday night dinner at the Golden Lamb, and 3 lunches as well as tickets to the outdoor drama *Tecumseh!*, which we will see in Chillicothe on Saturday evening. As usual, we are offering this trip at cost to members. Should you have to cancel prior to June 1, we will refund your fee. After that date, we cannot guarantee a full refund.
2. The field trip officially starts at 7:30 PM on Thursday evening June 13 at the Hampton Inn, Wilmington, Ohio (see #3) meeting room TBA. A brief introduction to Ohio Hopewell will be given, and a detailed itinerary will be distributed and discussed. We will also plan our carpool at this meeting,
3. **PLEASE MAKE YOUR OWN ROOM RESERVATIONS BY MAY 12.** For the nights of Thursday, June 13 and Friday, June 14 we will be staying at the Hampton Inn and Suites, 201 Holiday Drive Wilmington, Ohio. 45177-8923, 937-382-4400. Group rate with tax is \$172/ night for a double with two queens/king bed (effectively \$86/per person double occupancy). For the night of Saturday, June 15 we are staying at the Best Western Adena Inn, 1250 N. Bridge Street, Chillicothe, OH 45601, 740 775-7000. The group rate with tax is \$113/night for a double room with two queen beds/king bed (effectively \$56.50 double occupancy). Both these hotels offer free, hot breakfasts and parking. Please mention the Society for Pennsylvania Archaeology field trip and , if necessary, John Nass' name when registering.
4. As mentioned above this year's trip includes a group dinner on Friday night at the Golden Lamb in Lebanon, PA (<https://www.goldenlamb.com/about-us/our-story/>), which has been "a house of public entertainment" since 1803. Today's restaurant, which is close to the Fort Ancient State Memorial, offers "historical fare" to groups such as ours. We also have purchased group tickets to the outdoor drama *Tecumseh!* (<https://tecumseh-drama.com/>) This outdoor drama reportedly is a truly different theater experience. Our group tickets also entitle us to a behind the scenes tour, which we hope to fit in before dinner.

This field trip will require a moderate amount of walking, sometimes over uneven ground as well as standing for extended periods so that individuals with limited mobility may not be able to participate. We cannot provide any special handicapped accommodation for this field trip. Please wear sensible shoes and clothing and plan to be outside in all kinds of summer weather.
7. We request that all participants be fully vaccinated against the Covid-19 virus; we ask you to indicate vaccination status when applying and will use the honor system rather than require proof. Masking for inside activities will be optional. If you are not feeling well, please do not attend. The SPA cannot be responsible for your health or for difficulties/expense should you be ill during the trip.
