**Collections and Curation Committee**—Janet Johnson reported that the State Museum received the collection of Fred Veigh. With the help of Brian Fritz, Amanda Valko and Bob Oshnock the collection was packed and transported to Harrisburg. It is a massive and important collection.

Janet is working on a new Discover and Preserve rack card to be used to promote donations of artifact collections. It will be sent to the board for review and funding.

Site Survey/PASS forms—Noel Strattan reported the 2015 site recording results. No sites were reported in 2015 by anyone identifying themselves as a member of the SPA, therefore no Frances Dorrance award will be presented this year. All the sites recorded came from CRM work. Both new and revised site forms are counted. The total for 2015 is 635 new sites with total sites recorded in Pennsylvania at 24,138.
